# 2011-2012 NCRHA Team Registration Packet

**All materials are to be submitted to your Member Organization. Unless otherwise noted, all materials must be received by your Member Organization by October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2011 or 72 hours before your team's first game.**

Please use the enclosed Team Checklist to ensure that all registration materials have been completed. Your specific Member Organization may have additional registration materials that must be completed before league play can commence. Please consult your league director for details.

If at any time you have any questions or concerns, do not hesitate to contact the league using the information provided in this document.

New documentation is forthcoming for 2011-2012, including an updated League Operations Manual and Rulebook. All documentation will be posted online in the NCRHA Document Center at <http://ncrha.org/documents.php>. A summary of these changes will be posted on [www.ncrha.org](http://www.ncrha.org) as soon as they are finalized.

## ITEMS OF NOTE FOR THE 2011-2012 SEASON

### 1. Inter-Regional Events

The NCRHA, in conjunction with all NCRHA Member Organizations, will be working to bring Division I teams (as well as all other divisions, pending availability) several opportunities to compete in Inter-Regional Events during the season. Information will be announced on [www.ncrha.org](http://www.ncrha.org) as soon as it is available. Throughout the past 2 years, over 30 teams have taken part in this experience, and therefore better prepared themselves for the Collegiate Roller Hockey National Championships.

### 2. Collegiate Roller Hockey National Championships

The NCRHA is working towards securing sites and dates for the next 2 National Championship Tournaments. Information will be posted on [www.ncrha.org](http://www.ncrha.org) as soon as it is available.

### 3. Continued NCRHA Marketing/PR

The NCRHA was represented at Narch Finals and again this summer. The NCRHA realizes that youth are the future of our sport, and that our presence at these large events is crucial to our overall longevity. We are also "doing our part" to keep interest alive in the sport of roller hockey. We are there to show these young players that they can continue playing all the way through high school and into college.

The NCRHA is working with one of their sponsors, Mission Hockey, to once again bring you a Mission Hockey College at an event in your area. Over 30 Mission Hockey Colleges have been held over the past 4 seasons. The Mission Hockey College is a clinic for the youth of the area to come out and skate with college roller hockey players and be mentored on improving skills, etc. Your Member Organization Director will be contacted in order to get you involved in helping out with this event. ### 4. Payments

- All league fee payments are to be submitted to your Member Organization. They will be invoicing you for both your Regular Season and for your NCRHA Registration Fees. No payments are necessary to the NCRHA, except for the NCRHA Winterfest and Collegiate Roller Hockey National Championships.
- National Championships Fees – All fees paid for entrance to the National Championships (or Winter Invitational) are non-refundable; Alternates are fully refundable unless they accept a spot from a dropped team.
- The NCRHA continues its policy of not accepting personal checks. The NCRHA will be collecting a \$25 fee for all NSF (insufficient funds) checks.



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To all players, staff, parents, alumni,

Welcome to another exciting season of collegiate roller hockey. 2011-2012 marks the 17<sup>th</sup> year that a collegiate roller hockey champion has been crowned, and the 14<sup>th</sup> year that a national governing body for collegiate roller hockey has officially sanctioned the sport and held a "True National Championship."

The 2010-2011 Collegiate Roller Hockey National Championships were held in Madison, WI at the Capitol Ice Arena. The Long Beach State 49ers defeated the Cal Poly San Luis Obispo Mustangs in Division I; University of Miami Hurricanes defeated the Florida Gulf College University Eagles in Division II; St. Charles CC Cougars defeated the St. Louis Community College Magic in the Junior College Division; and Lindenwood University Lions defeated the West Chester University of Pennsylvania Rams in the B Division.

Once again, you will be asked to submit your registration paperwork no later than October 15th or 72 hours before your first game of the season, whichever occurs first. All completed registration materials are to be mailed or handed to your Member Organization Director, not to the NCRHA office.

If you look at the checklist provided on the following pages, you will have a comprehensive listing of everything you need to do to prepare for the upcoming season. Due dates for paperwork are included where applicable. Do not hesitate to submit anything you have completed before the due date – we appreciate having completed materials early. Your Member Organization may have several documents in addition to this packet that are required in order to register.

One item of note is that the NCRHA is sanctioning this season with USA Roller Sports. You will find information in this packet with information on how to register for USARS membership. Also a press release is available on [www.ncrha.org](http://www.ncrha.org) with more information on this important partnership.

A Letter of Recognition of the team as an official student organization is to be submitted by the due date on the checklist. An administrator at your school must complete this and sign with their information. Additionally, forms have been provided to verify that all players on your team are taking the requisite number of credits at your school. Please note that these forms must be completed for ALL players on the roster. They must be signed and/or stamped by your registrar to be accepted.

Please, use the web site tools that have been provided for you! I am always surprised at the number of high school players who write NCRHA and already know everything about the roller hockey teams at the schools they are considering. Make sure your information on the website is updated and post articles regularly. Additionally, use the PPS Administration Area to check on the status of your registration paperwork. A short summary on using PPS is provided in this packet.

Finally, good luck to all teams in the upcoming 2011-2012 season. See you on the rink!

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## NCRHA.org and PowerPlayStats.com

Once again, the NCRHA has contracted with PowerPlayStats™ (PPS) to bring you updated standings, stats and scores. Below is a brief summary of the areas online that you will need to keep up-to-date this year, as well as instructions on how to do so.

### **\*\*Team Representatives Only\*\***

(players do not need to login to PowerPlayStats)

### **Logging In**

Go to your member organization site or [www.NCRHA.org](http://www.NCRHA.org) and click on the PPS icon. Click on “Admin Login” at the bottom of the page. You will be brought to the PPS login page. Your login is tied to your email address. Enter your email address and password (same as last year). If you have forgotten your password, you can have a new one sent to you by clicking the “Forgot Password” link immediately below the login box.

\*\*If you are a brand new team, can't access your team information or don't know if you have an email address set up, contact your Member Organization Director for your login information.

### **Changing Your Password**

Chances are good that you'll never remember the password that was created for you. After logging in, click on the “My Account” section on the top right and update your password through the “Change Password” button.

### **League and Content Menus**

The main two pull-down menus to be concerned with are League and Content. Those will lead you to adding players to your roster, posting news articles about your team, etc. Please feel free to explore all of the drop-down menus as soon as possible, to ease your familiarity with the site.

### **Team Representative Responsibilities on PowerPlayStats**

- Teams and Players Link – Rosters – Add players to your team roster for the season. Use the Roster Past Player link for any existing player. Use Add New Player(s) link for any new players. You will then search for them to see if they are already in the system. Note: Players may exist on PPS already if they played in AIHL or PIHA, State Wars, various high school leagues or another NCRHA team.
- Franchises Link – Update your franchise information – Change Officers – You can delete past officers at the bottom of the page and add yourself and any new officers. This information shows up on your team page under Front Office.



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### Online Registration (\*\*All players and coaches to register online\*\*)

The NCRHA and its Member Organizations will continue with the regional Online Registration websites. Similar to last season, all Member Organizations will be using Online Registration, in addition to the documents within this Team Registration Packet.

All registered users will enter or be asked to update their email address, emergency contact information, etc. This will enable League Officials on-site to have access to your emergency contact information, should it be necessary, and with your approval. Having your email address on file will allow your Member Organization and the NCRHA to include you in their mailings, which will include news articles from around the nation, sponsorship/vendor details, league news such as bids to the National Championship Tournament, etc.

#### 2. Click on Registration (left side of page)

##### Process for New Players, Coaches or Team Staff

- Click on the "Click here" link next to New Player or New Coach. (Other team staff should register as a Coach)
- Using the tabs under "Registration - New Player" (or "Coach"), enter in all required information.
- Choose your team under the Team tab. If your team is not listed, stop immediately and email your Member Organization Director.
- Once finished, click the "Submit" tab. Then click on the "Submit" button.

##### Process for Returning Players, Coaches or Team Staff

- Click on the "Login" link next to "Returning Participants."
- Enter your email address and password from the previous season (use Forgot Password if you do not remember your password).
- Visit the "Eligibility section of the "BackOffice" to determine what you need to turn in to be eligible to participate.
- Update "My Information." Make sure to click on the "Submit" button on the "Submit" tab to save your changes.
- Note: You may need to accept the Code of Conduct when you register for the new season.

\*\*Should you have any issues, contact your Member Organization Director for more information.

**\*\*Team Representatives** – Notify your Member Organization Director once you have registered. They can change your access to that of a Team Representative and you will have increased functionality.

**\*\*Team Representatives** – Member Organization Directors will distribute information to Team Representatives on managing your team on your registration website. Team Representatives will have further responsibilities once all players are in and the team rep access has been granted. Team Representatives will have the ability to log in and view the eligibility of each player on their team at any time.



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## League Sanction/Membership/Insurance

All players, coaches, and team staff are required to register with USA Roller Sports for the 2011-2012 season. Information on insurance coverage is available on the following pages, and on page 2 of the USARS Membership Application.

**One item of note:** All players must use the NCRHA-specific paper form that is provided in the following pages or in the NCRHA Documents section of [www.ncrha.org](http://www.ncrha.org) ([www.ncrha.org/documents.php](http://www.ncrha.org/documents.php)). The reason for this is that USA Roller Sports uses the calendar year for coverage (Jan. 1 to Dec. 31) and the NCRHA uses the dates of the season (Sept. 1 to Aug. 31). USA Roller Sports has created this NCRHA-specific form so that all NCRHA players and coaches will be covered from the day they submit the paperwork until December 31, 2012. This encompasses the full 2011-2012 NCRHA season.

**\*\*All players must be registered/insured prior to taking part in any NCRHA-sanctioned activity. Consult your Member Organization Director for specific requirements.\*\***

All players and coaches are to submit insurance paperwork and payment to their Member Organization Director.

- I, the undersigned, do affirm the registration information above is correct and truthful and hereby make application to USARS for amateur registration with which to identify myself at sanctioned competitions, exhibitions and other appropriate occasions. I further agree to abide by the rules and regulations of USARS during the terms of this registration and agree to observe the Amateur Code of Conduct, in spirit as well as in letter, upholding the high ethics of amateur roller skating.
- I understand dangers may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in these activities. I understand the nature of USARS' activities and believe that I (or my minor child) am/are qualified and physically fit to participate in roller skating competitions and practices. I further acknowledge that I am aware that the activity will be conducted in facilities open to the public. As a skater, parent or legal guardian, I further agree and warrant that prior to participating in any event I will inspect the facilities to be used and if believing conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately advise my coach or the meet director of this condition and refuse to participate unless corrected.
- I fully understand that USARS' activities involve risks and dangers of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death, and economic losses which might result not only from a skater's actions, inactions or negligence, but the action, inaction, or negligence of others, the rules of competition, or the condition of the premises or any equipment in use. I fully accept and assume all such risks and responsibilities for losses and costs and damages incurred as a result of my participation in USARS activities or arising out of my traveling to or returning from such activities or practice sessions.
- I hereby release, discharge, covenant not to sue, and agree to hold harmless USARS, their administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and where applicable, owners and lessors of premises and their employees on which the activity takes place (collectively "Releasees"), from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the Releasees. # USA ROLLER SPORTS

## ACCIDENT INSURANCE INFORMATION

### Effective Date

The effective date for the USA Roller Sports excess accident/medical expense benefit program is the time the athlete signs and dates this application and remits full payment to a USARS representative, initiating the individual into the master policy and confirming membership in USA Roller Sports. This application and full payment must be received at USARS Headquarters, 4730 South Street, Lincoln, NE 68506, within 10 days of the date on the application in order for the insurance to remain valid. Giving payment to a coach or club president could compromise your insurance coverage if the preceding timeline is not followed.

### Who and What is Covered

**Competitors/Coaches**-Registered member skaters/coaches of USA Roller Sports are provided with excess (secondary) accident/medical expense benefits in the amount of \$50,000 for injuries occurring **ON SKATES** limited to organized and supervised practice sessions held within USA Roller Sports chartered club facilities, or during USA Roller Sports sanctioned competitions and/or USA Roller Sports training sessions sanctioned by national headquarters specified to occur outside of club facilities. The event must be supervised by a club officer (or an official USA Roller Sports coach) or the USA Roller Sports designated leader of an USA Roller Sports sponsored event. The individual will be required to certify the validity of the claim being submitted. No coverage is extended to a skater injured while on skates, but who is not in training for USA Roller Sports competitions.

**Non-Competitive Card Holders/USA Roller Sports Officials**-Coverage is limited to accidents occurring both on or off skates while actually participating in a competition that is progress. Practice sessions, other than sanctioned competitive event practices, are **not** covered.

### What is Not Covered

Training off skates or training outside of chartered club facilities, unless specified by a USA Roller Sports sanction, or any injury occurring while on skates but while not training for USA Roller Sports competitions is **not** covered. Sickness is **not** covered. Pre-existing conditions are **not** covered and shall mean any condition for which treatment has been provided within (6) months prior to such injury. Re-injury **is** considered a pre-existing condition.

### Benefits Summary

A deductible is applied per accident before any benefits are payable. Secondary accident medical reimbursement will pay 100% of the excess over payment by your primary plan. Please note there are different deductible amounts depending on whether the USARS member has primary insurance or not.

**For complete benefit amounts please refer to the actual policy posted on the USA Roller Sports website ([www.usarollersports.org](http://www.usarollersports.org)).**

**Excess Coverage**-All benefits are payable on an EXCESS BASIS. This means that your primary policy must pay the charge on each bill (that are payable under that policy's contract) before this insurance will pay. Proof of these payments must be submitted to the claims payer.

**Accident Medical Expense**-If, as a result of an injury, an insured incurs covered expenses starting within 30 days of the date of the accident, up to \$50,000 will be paid for covered expenses incurred within 52 weeks of the initial injury.

**Deductible**-Is met by personal payments totaling the deductible amount for the injury for which you are submitting the claim. If you have no other insurance coverage, you will be responsible for the deductible amount in medical and /or dental expenses. Meeting the annual deductible for your group or any other insurance does not satisfy this requirement.

**Basis For Payment**-“Usual and Customary” or “Reasonable and Customary” rates. Your doctor's billing clerk will understand these terms. You will be responsible for any amount that exceeds total payable benefit.

**Accident Report & Claims Forms** - An accident report (available online) **must** be filed with USA Roller Sports by the injured individual and signed by a club officer within 30 days of the date of injury. Claim forms will be mailed by USA Roller Sports to the injured party after receipt of a completed and signed accident report form and all insurance criteria are met. The club president must verify the rink circumstances and when the injury occurred. To initiate the claims process, contact USA Roller Sports 402.483.7551, within 30 days of the accident.

## OTHER INFORMATION

**USA Roller Sports Magazine:** Each USARS membership includes a subscription for all remaining issues of USA Roller Sports magazine published during the current membership season (a \$12.00 value). If membership is not renewed at the beginning of the season, you will not receive the magazine until membership is renewed. Our quarterly magazine is issued in January, April, July, and October.

**\*World Team Endowment Gift:** An additional payment equal to your membership amount represents a charitable contribution to USA Roller Sports for use in establishing an endowment fund to support athlete travel in international competition. In recognition of this gift, a special commemorative pin will be sent to the member.

**\*National Museum of Roller Skating:** Established in 1980, the National Museum of Roller Skating provides the public with an experience to reflect and understand the sport and recreation of roller skating and its history. To ensure the continuation of the museum and its service to the public, please consider joining the museum as a member. 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## School Acknowledgment Letter

Every NCRHA member team must have a school acknowledgment letter on file for the current calendar year in order to be eligible for league play. **This is in addition to any letter required by your regional Member Organization.** The letter must fit the following criteria:

- Must appear on **official** university or college letterhead
