West Valley College plays in the National Collegiate Roller Hockey Association. Visit https://ncrha.org/ for more information about the league.

Student enrollment commitment: players must stay enrolled in a minimum of 6 verifiable units per semester to be eligible. Students can play a maximum of 3 seasons for any Junior College.

Student time commitment: 4 games are typically played per weekend over 4 weekends. Ten mandatory practices will typically be scheduled twice per month on Fridays at 9:30-10:30pm September through March.

Game weekends are *tentative* and should not conflict with any travel hockey tournaments:
October 27 & 28 in San Jose (CONFIRMED)
November TBS in Huntington Beach
Santa Barbara and Chico in Jan/Feb (1 weekend each)

Cost is dependent on number of players selected per team. \$100 deposit is REQUIRED upon team

confirmation the night of tryout as well as money for jerseys, which is a min. of \$110 for jersey set (mandatory) and \$55 for pants (optional). Additional league fees of approximately \$380 per player are required and due by Oct. 1st this excludes personal travel expenses, championship fees and practices. (All efforts are made to minimize per player costs)

The 2018 Championship location and dates have not been announced. Last season we were in Fargo ND. Nats usually take place the first weekend in April.
